### **Water Bottles**

- Completing our Golden Book activities

- Developing our climbing and balancing skills on our obstacle course

### Our skill of the week

This week we are talking about our feelings and trying to recognise a wider range of feelings through stories. Our two year olds are being encouraged to develop an emotional response to a book e.g. laughing. At home it is really useful to practise labelling our feelings and those of our children so they can start to understand when they are sad, cross, happy. Stories are a great way of developing this by talking about how the character must be feeling.

## Reading focus

During our 1:1 reading sessions with the children we are developing play linked to our favourite stories. At home, you could encourage children to act out some of their favourite parts.

### **Forest School**

This term we are continuing to take children to explore at Forest School wearing their wellies and coats. We will need the children's waterproofs after February half term.

### **Concept Words**

Concepts are words that shape how we think about the world. For instance, concepts such as 'early', 'night' or 'after' help us talk about time. Concepts are hard to learn but they are fundamental to learning, so they are worth spending time on.

We will be regularly learning new concepts through lots of fun activities – with one focus word each week. The more your child hears the new words in different situations, the better their understanding of the concept will be. You can help your child to learn the concept of the week by carrying out the suggested activity in the concept word box below in the weekly overview of learning.
