Dear Parents/Carers,

Y1 - Y6 Music Evening - Thursday 22 February 2024

This year's Music Evening will be held on Thursday 22 February at 6.00pm. Any pupil who plays a musical instrument is invited to sign up on the sheet outside Mrs Ball's door (RB) no later than Wednesday 7 February 2024. Children will need to write what instrument they will be playing alongside their name and class. All children that write their names down will be included in Music Evening.

Depending on which year group your child is in, they will need to bring their instrument and sheet music to school on the day of their Year group's Talent Show as this will double up as their 'dress rehearsal'. The Talent Shows are taking place in school, for children only, on:

Y3 and Y5 – Thursday 8 February (pm)

Y1 and Y2 – Friday 9 February (pm)

Y4 and Y6 - Friday 9 February (pm)

This year, the Y5 choir club and the Y4 Ukulele club will be performing at the Music Evening. If parents/carers wish to take their children, from these clubs, home at the interval, please do so. Other performers should stay for the whole event to support their peers as they perform.

As always, we welcome all parents/carers, family and friends to come and watch your child perform and enjoy Music Evening with us. Children performing will need to be at school at 5.40pm. They will need to be looking smart in their school uniform and are allowed to bring a light snack and water bottle with them (no sweets, chocolate or sugary drinks please). On arrival, the children will meet in 1S (Mrs Smith's classroom).

On the day of Music Evening, the children can leave their instruments in their classroom and bring them to 1S after school. Please ensure your child also has any other necessary bits and pieces such as spare reeds, foot-stools or straps!

Family and friends should arrive at 5.50pm so that the evening can begin promptly at 6.00pm. However, if you are dropping your child off at 5.40pm you will be able to enter the hall and relax. The PTA will be running a bar in the Hall/Club Room where refreshments will be available to purchase before the performance and during the interval. Entrance and exit for the evening will be via the school entrance by the Office. Unfortunately, the West Gate will not be open.
