 details must be current so that parents can be contacted in the event of the child present for

- If a child is unable to attend a club then the teacher leading the club must be notified beforehand, parents@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk
- If your child is absent from school due to illness, please mention that they will not be attending the club when you fill in the absence Google Form.
- If a child misses two sessions without a valid reason, or is collected late on two occasions, their place will be offered to another child.
- Internal Extra Curricular clubs will finish promptly, so please be on time to collect your child.
- All children attending internal clubs will be expected to be ready, respectful and safe and unfortunately your child's club place will be in jeopardy if the school rules aren't followed.
- Y6 Parents/Carers should use the Google Form to indicate that permission is given for their child to walk home by themselves after the club has finished.

We have also included information for the rest of the year so you can see what is on offer. Please note, these clubs are still in draft form and will be confirmed each half term when another Google Form will be emailed home.
