Learning questions:

What are the signs of the season of spring?
What do Christians believe happened in the 'Easter Story?'

This week we will be thinking about the upcoming season of spring and changes that occur in nature around this time. We will think about the four seasons and how each is different and unique. We will be creating some artwork to represent the changes we are learning about.

We will also look at the Christian story of Easter and think about the ways in which people might celebrate this occasion.

The key learning and skills we will focus on this week are:

- Using 'because' to give reasons for events/actions.
- Using correct letter formation for all letters
- Reading short phrases and sentences
- Experimenting with a range of materials for different creative purposes.

- Talking about how to solve a particular problem and deciding together what to do
- Leaving a space between words.
- Finding out about the different beliefs that people have
- Experimenting with moving a range of balls in different ways
- Subitising up to 10 using a ten frame to support thinking

Phonics

Most children are now confident with recognising all the single letter sounds, but there are one or two letters that can be a bit tricky.

Practice is the only way to get better at anything!

If your child tends to muddle up 'b' and 'd' you could watch these sound lessons a few times together to help them consolidate:

Maths


Our focus in maths continues to be on the great importance of the parts and wholes of numbers from 1-8. We will recap our understanding of subtraction using a variety of methods and will record our findings using a written number sentence.


When we're thinking about subtraction we can remember 'When we subtract a part from the whole, the other part is left.'

Subtracting a part from the whole:

When you subtract a **part** from the **whole** the other part is left.

Whole - part = part





Show and Tell

Our new theme for Show and Tell this half term is 'something I have made'. This is a great opportunity for your child to learn about the world around them and to get busy making – try to allow your child to come up with their own idea so that they enjoy the process. For example – your child might like to: make a factual poster about jungle animals/write a story/ build a vehicle using junk modelling/ collage/ paint/ make puppets/prepare some food etc. The list is endless! If your child's creation is too difficult to bring into school a photo will be a good way of sharing it. You can either print this off or email it to your child's class teacher.
