## Strategic Plan 2024 - 2029



The Strategic Plan is a high level, long term plan, extending over a period of five years, to guide our growth and development. It sets out the school's vision and values as well as our commitments to the children as they are at the heart of the strategic objectives.

The Strategic Plan is complemented by the Raising Achievement Plan (RAP), an ambitious short term operational plan. The RAP is developed by the Leadership and Management Team and sets out operationally how the long term strategy of the school is to be achieved.

Our School Commitments:	The school's vision and motto are brought to life through our seven commitments (see below), to each child, during their journey with us.

### Strategic Objectives

The strategic objectives will inform and guide decisions and choices that are made over the coming years as the educational and governance context evolves.

Whatever their starting point, children leaving Stamford Green, will be equipped with the skills, experiences and knowledge to thrive and adapt in an ever changing world. They will appreciate and be inspired by the diversity of the natural environment, people and cultures around them.

4	Investing in dynamic, high quality learning and play environments, to support the curriculum and wider school life.
5	Ensuring the school's financial stability to enable future choices.
6	Promoting belonging, well being and resilience for the whole school community, adapting and working as a team to aid recruitment and retention.
7	Proactive and innovative provision, which aims to meet the needs of all learners.

## Monitoring and Evaluation

The Raising Achievement Plan (RAP), describes how this strategy is to be implemented in the short to medium term.

The Governing Body will triangulate information from various sources to monitor and evaluate to what extent the strategic objectives are being met.

## Review

The Strategic Plan will be reviewed annually at the first Governing Body meeting of the school year. It will be revised every three years, whilst maintaining a long term perspective, extending over five years.
