#### This week we are:

- Starting our new theme of learning 'Whatever Next'.
- We are building lots of creations using junk modelling materials linked to our story Whatever Next.
- Looking at the sunflower seeds we planted before half term and seeing if they have grown.
- Exploring new growth at Forest School.
- Continuing to practise cutting with scissors.

#### Our skill of the week

This week we are practising joining junk modelling materials with sellotape. We will be encouraging the children to be independent and show them how to use the sellotape dispenser.

#### Reading focus

During our 1:1 reading sessions with the children we are exploring alliteration. When reading out loud we will help the children spot alliteration. The younger children will practice copying and saying words that begin with the same sound.
