## Annie Jnr – Drama Club Information

We would welcome your support in helping your child to learn their lines and songs. At the moment, there are still many children who do not know their lines and so please ensure that they continue to practise them, as a little and often really does help.

## Rehearsals

In order to be ready for our performance on the 25 April, it has become necessary to add in some further rehearsal dates for the week beginning 15 April. We thank you for your help with the children attending these rehearsals.

Thursday 18 April 3.10pm – 4.45pm Friday 19 April 3.10pm – 4.10pm

There will not be any after school rehearsals during the week beginning 22 April as it is the week of the performance.

## Costumes

Please see below for a list of the costumes required. We would be grateful if all costumes could be in school by Monday 22 April 2024. Costumes should be in a named carrier bag and put in the costume box in 1S. Please see below for some ideas for costumes. Footwear should consist of plain black pumps, school shoes, plimsolls or dance shoes, so that the children can move around the stage quietly. If your child is more than one character, we will need a costume for each of their roles please.

Role in the show	Costume required
Annie	Annie should be dressed like the other orphans – layers of ragged clothing, tattered socks and an oversized jumper. We will provide the rest of Annie's costume
Orphans	The orphans appear ragged and shabby. Layering ill-fitting, rumpled mismatched and faded clothing is perfect.
Miss Hannigan	Dull coloured dress, bright coloured beaded necklace
Bundles McCloskey	Oversized shirt, trousers, deliveryman' cap.
Apple seller	Coat, scarf, hat, fingerless gloves
Police officer/Dog catcher	Navy blue shirt, trousers, police hat
Grace	Professional suit, hat, gloves
Drake	Drake should look polished and formal – white shirt, black trousers, black jacket, white gloves
Servants	Typical Victorian servants – black dress, white apron, matching hat
Oliver Warbucks	Formal dress – dark suit, white shirt, bow tie
Rooster	Rooster's costume should be as colourful as possible! Bright jacket, dark shirt, braces, dark trousers
Lily	Bright dress, handbag, bracelets

Bert Healy	Suit and tie
President Roosevelt & Louis Howe	Dark suit, white shirt, tie, small glasses
New Yorkers	1930s characters – dresses, trousers and shirt

## Tickets

Tickets will go on sale from 12.00pm on Tuesday 16 April via Scopay and will be priced at £7.00 per ticket. We will be restricting the number of tickets to four per child in the production initially to allow everyone to get a ticket and we will notify you if there are remaining tickets. then will be opening the limited number of tickets remaining on general sale on Friday 19 April.

We will write again nearer the performance dates to explain what time children need to arrive at school to get into costume and have their hair and make-up done.

We are looking forward to sharing with you all the hard work that everyone has put into learning lines, songs and dance routines.
