Lunch is just before 12.00pm and school meals can be ordered <u>here</u> or you may bring a packed lunch. We are a nut free school to help keep those with allergies safe.

We have fresh fruit/vegetables from the School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme for a snack each morning. You may also bring some fruit to enjoy in the afternoon – no fruit bars or cereal bars please.

Please bring a plastic, sports cap water bottle to school each day – this should contain water only.
