Please name your child's jumper. We have lots of jumpers unnamed in nursery.


Mornings

- Looking at sets of objects and thinking about which one is the odd one out and explaining our thoughts.
- Exploring light and shadows using our new light box.
- Recognising and writing numbers 1 - 5.

This weeks concept words:

2 year olds

This week's concept word is: **empty**

Help your child at home: Play Jenga or build towers and talk about the bottom pieces.

3 and 4 year olds

This week's concept word is: **over**

Help your child at home: When the child is sitting on your lap, talk about you being at the back of them

Our skill of the week

This week we are practising how to manage our own buttons and zips. Our younger children will be practising how to confidently play alone or with others.

Reading focus

During our 1:1 reading sessions with the children we are practicing orally blending sounds to make words. It would be great if you could practise this at home. At this stage ,please give lots of demonstrations and support. By orally blending we mean saying the sounds to simple words and then saying the whole word. For example, "c" "a" "t" – "cat". It is important we say the pure sounds, please follow the link to find out what we mean when we say to use the pure sound.
