Godstone Farm

We are really looking forward to our trip to Godstone Farm this Wednesday. We will be leaving at approximately 9.15am and we should be back at school by 4.00pm, although this is dependent on traffic. We will update the school X feed on the school website with details of our journey. The children should wear **tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts with their school polo shirt, school jumper and trainers**. In addition, please send a **small rucksack containing a named sunhat, named waterproof jacket and lunch/snacks**. If your child usually has a school meal on a Wednesday, a packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen. If you wish to send additional snacks to supplement the lunch then you are most welcome to but please respect that we are a nut free school and don't send too much! If you have not booked a school lunch, please provide a packed lunch from home. Children will also need to bring a full water bottle with them.


Learning question:

This week we will think about why people celebrate Father's Day. We will be talking about how we may have other people in our lives, as well as, or in addition to, fathers who are special to us and take care of us such as uncles, grandfathers, older brothers.

We will also have a Godstone Farm trip 'briefing', which will help to prepare the children for their educational visit to the farm on Wednesday. This will include aspects of staying safe, being respectful and showing our school values. We will talk about what they can expect on the day and address any questions the children have ahead of the visit.

The key learning and skills we will focus on are:


- Automatically recall some number bonds to 10 including doubles facts.
- Reflect on what went well and what they might improve on their creations.
- Use past, present and future tenses to share ideas and narratives
- Read some common exception words (red words)
- Using large and small paintbrushes/ sponges etc appropriately for different tasks.
- Writing can be read by others.
- Hit a ball with a bat or racquet.
- Know how to be a safe pedestrian.
- Explore and investigate what happens when different substances are mixed.

Phonics Please make sure you are reading with your child 5 times every week, practicing the sounds they have been learning in their daily Phonics sessions.	Reading This week's revisited red words are: we, so, me Please review all of the red words: I, my, the, you, said, your, are, be, of, no, what, all, was, we, so, to, me, call, her, there, went, go, old, some, he
Concept Word This week's concept word is: biggest  Help at home: at home, go from room to room and see who has the biggest bed.	


Maths

Sharing:

There are 2 groups of 3 sweets. The whole is 6.




How many are in each group?




In maths this week we will start to think about sharing which will be the beginning of our learning about division. We will think about whether we can share an amount equally, and then think about the parts that make the whole. If there are 6 sweets and we share them equally between 2 friends, there are 2 groups of 3 and the whole is 6. We will think about what happens if the number is odd.

Our theme for Show and Tell this half term is **'Something from an adventure.'** This is a great opportunity for your child to reflect on an adventure they have shared with their family. They might like to share some photos of a special day, or bring in an artefact or souvenir which they found. Other examples of things they might like to do are make a model/paint a picture/write a diary entry/make a poster to represent a place they visited or an adventure they have been on. It really is up to them and the list is endless! If your child's creation is too difficult to bring into school a photo will be a good way of sharing it.
