School Evaluation Document (SED) - We recognise the importance of self-evaluation as a crucial part of our school's ongoing cycle of reviewing and planning. The SED and SSP evaluation will outline the progress our pupils and school are making against our strategic objectives.

Strategic Plan Review

The plan will be reviewed annually at the first Governing Body meeting of the school year. It will be revised every 3 years, whilst maintaining a long-term perspective, extending over 5 years.
