Our skill of the week

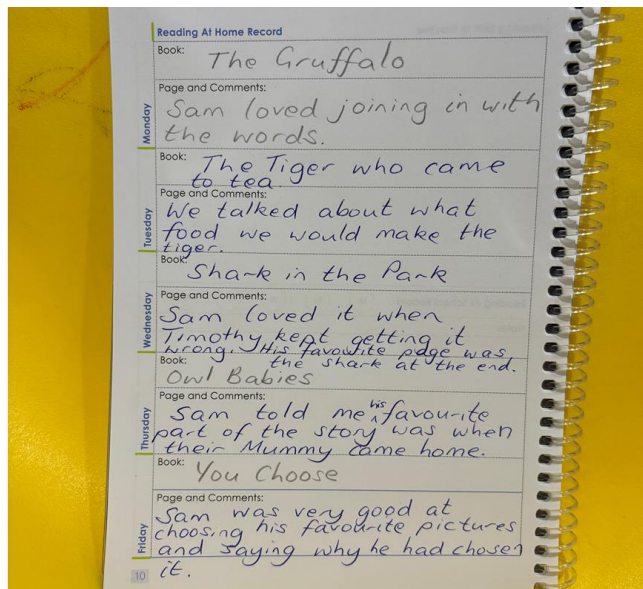

All the children will be sharing a story with their Key Worker this week and enjoying choosing a book to take home. Please record any reading that happens at home in the Learning Journal provided. Book bags need to be brought to school every day.

Once the children are settled we will be putting a box of books at South and West Gates every day so you can change your child's book regularly.

If you drop your child off to the South Gate in the morning, please be aware that other children will also access school via this Gate at the same time. Please can all nursery parents line up next to the school building in order for others to pass. Please only allow your child to walk through the Gate once a member of nursery has arrived.

When collecting your child at the end of the day the best thing you can do is to give your child your full attention as they leave nursery. They will be very excited to see you!

Another helpful tip is to bring a small healthy snack to the gate. It could be a piece of fruit, a pack of raisins, some breadsticks or something else they like to nibble on. It really helps avoid those end of day tantrums when they are tired and hungry and is also a great distraction!
