Reception Weekly Information - Week Beginning 9.9.24

Dates to note:

Thursday **12.9.24** bring PE bags into school (eventually, these will be sent home each week for washing).

Wednesday **18.9.24** bring Wellies into school (these stay at school for use as needed).

Have you remembered?

- Children should bring a waterproof coat with a hood to school each day.
- Please make sure that everything is clearly named including shoes and wellies.
- Children may bring in a fruit snack in their Book Bags during the Staggered Entry Period but we will provide our school fruit too.
- Any child with hair longer than shoulder length should have it completely tied back at school (not in half up half down styles please).

A reminder of Staggered Entry Period timings: Monday 9 September - Tuesday 17 September
Group 1 (March – August birthdays) 9.00am - 11.30am
Group 2 (September – February birthdays) 12.30pm – 3.00pm

At drop off time the children will say goodbye outside the school gates and join the class line by themselves. Their teachers/TAs will be there to greet them and walk them up to the classroom. School staff will be on hand to help if your child is finding it a bit tricky.

We look forward to lots of fun during the rest of the week while we get to know each other and settle into the routines of school life.

Waterproof coat -
Even if it is sunny, your coat needs to be in school.



Book Bag – you are allowed one keyring on your Book Bag.

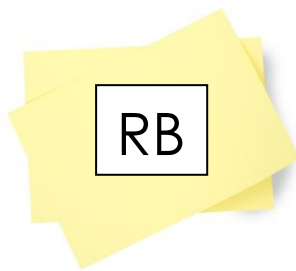


Named water bottle – please remind your child that this shouldn't be in their Book Bag.

Class sign for collection -
Your child will have brought home a coloured sign with their name and class on. Please bring this to hold up at the Gate when you collect your child each day. This will enable a smooth and quick pick up for the children and their teachers.



Fruit/vegetable snack -
When your child is full time please put a small fruit or vegetable snack in your their Book Bag for them to eat at snack time. During the Staggered Entry Period you may provide fruit if you would like to but school fruit will be provided.
