Year 3 Stone Age Workshop – Wednesday 13 November 2024

To complement our learning in history, and our enquiry question 'How did life change from the Paleolithic to the Iron Age?', we will be having a visit from Portals to the Past on Wednesday 13 November 2024. The visit will focus on the exploration of many of the important developments that helped to make us who we are: from the original hunter gathers to early farming communities, ancient technology and coming of the age of metal. The workshop will cover early humans and cave art; early farmers, settlements and stone monuments, the bronze age and the iron age.
