We are very excited to be welcoming parents and carers to our Class Assemblies on 11.3.25 and 13.3.25 8.45am - 9.30am

Class Assemblies take place each year, and are a chance for the children to share the things they have been learning.

Cygnets parents/carers please go to the classroom.

This week we are:

- Singing 'Miss Polly had a Dolly'
- Role-playing in our doctors surgery
- Continuing to develop our large muscle co-ordination playing with the parachute.
- Drawing large pictures of ourselves.
- Building strategies we can use to complete puzzles.
- Completing puzzles that show different countries and then discussing how they are different from where we live.
- Beginning to prepare for our class assembly.

Our skill of the week

This week our Swans are learning how to use the correct vocabulary when giving an instruction. For example when at home play 'Follow the leader' encourage them to say "Follow me" "I'm the leader" or "copy me". Our Cygnets are going to be exploring different textures. Encourage them to explore different foods at home, for example how each different fruit feels in the fruit basket.

Reading focus

During our 1:1 reading sessions with the Swans we are encouraging them to read their own name and the names of their friends. Our Cygnets will be encouraged to make choices and indicate their choice by pointing, for example when looking at a book ask them questions which require them to express a preference.

Concept Words

This week's concept words:	
2 year olds This week's concept word is: behind Help your child at home: Explore the home and let your child find places to go behind .	3 and 4 year olds This week's concept word is: back Help your child at home: When the child is sitting on your lap, talk about you being at the back of them.

Handy hints:

What to do if your child doesn't sit when eating.

Keep to a routine so they know it is about to happen. Let them know dinner is soon and when they need to wash their hands.

Have the food ready to serve so they don't need to wait too long.

Get them involved as much as possible for example preparing the food or setting the table with you.

Eat together, this way they have company and can see good habits from others around them.

Don't allow them to walk away from the table while eating. Seat them back at the table if they get up.

If they are struggling to stay and eat or seem disinterested in their food, limit snacks between meals so they are not full when they sit down.

A booster seat with a strap may be necessary when establishing good habits.

Please let us know if you would like any handy hints to support any particular issues you may be having, we can promise you that you won't be alone so it's always worth sharing ideas!
