This week's concept words:

2 year olds

This week's concept word is: **lots**

Help your child at home: what can you spot lots of on the way home? For example, lots of cars, cats, trees, houses and lamp posts.

3 and 4 year olds

This week's concept word is: **side**

Help your child at home: look around the living room or bedroom and talk about what is at the side of the sofa, bed or television.

Our skill of the week

This week we are practicing using tools and materials to join and create sculptures, inspired by the following artists: Sheela Gowda, Andy Goldsworthy, Chila Kumari Singh Burman and Tony Cragg. We will be joining strips of paper to make our own sculptures.

Reading Focus

During our 1:1 reading sessions with the children we are using story language to act out familiar books. We will be recalling some of our favourite stories we have listened to so far this year.

Forest School

Now the weather is (finally) warming up and drying out we do not need waterproofs if the forecast for that day is dry. Please keep an eye out for the weather forecast on the day. The children always wear their wellies to protect their legs but the weather gets too warm for waterproofs. If rain is forecast please send waterproofs as usual.
