Dear Parents/Carers,

Golden Hinde Trip – Final Details **3L – 3/4 June, 3MD – 4/5 June & 3J – 5/6 June 2025**

We are looking forward to the trip and as the date approaches please find some useful information below:

Medical Requirements

Please can you complete the medical requirement [Google Form](#) for children attending, by 9.00am on **Monday 19 May**. This will ensure that all aspects of care for your child have been covered and will be clear for staff when preparing for the trip. There is also a section to complete to let staff know if we have permission to administer Calpol and/or Piriton should it be required and we will always let you know if it has been given to them.

Travel Arrangements

We will be departing school after registration on the day of the trip and will be returning to school at approximately 11.00am on the day of return. On the morning of the trip, please bring your child to school at the normal time. We will meet in our classrooms, where medicines and pocket money will be collected.

Meals

The children will need to have a packed lunch and their water bottle for the first day. We recommend that you pack a 'generous' lunch and some small snacks. This should be brought in a small rucksack to be worn during the day. Alternatively, you can book a lunch from Accent, the school caterers, for the day of departure. Please make sure you book this by **Monday 19 May**. The evening meal and breakfast the following morning will be provided on board the ship. The evening meal will consist of a pasty and breakfast will include bread, cheese, fruit and hot chocolate. Please note, there are no alternatives to what is provided. Please do not pack an extra meal for tea or breakfast for your child as they are encouraged to eat what they are given and are not allowed to keep food in their bags on the ship.

We already hold information about pupils' dietary requirements, including food allergies so there is no need for you to tell us this again. If you would like to update any information we hold, please contact Mrs Ravago in the school office via parents@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk

Pick up/Lunch arrangements on the day of return

We are offering parents/carers the option to either collect their child from school at 12.30pm, or they can stay at school until the normal finishing time of 3.15pm/3.20pm. If your child stays at school, they will have a relaxed afternoon after their overnight trip. Please let us know, via the Google Form if you will be collecting your child at 12.30pm.

If you would like your child to stay at school until 3.15pm/3.20pm, on the day of return, then your child can either have the option of having a school lunch for that day (which you will need to order for them, in the usual way) or alternatively you will need to bring in a packed lunch for them to have.

Groups

The children will be accompanied by members of staff at all times. The groups will be all together most of the time. However, individual groups may go off with their group leader at The Tower of London. The children will all sleep together on the gun deck on the Golden Hinde along with all members of school staff.

Pocket money

The Golden Hinde has a small gift shop which the children will have an opportunity to visit. The shop sells a variety of souvenirs. If you so wish, your child may take a maximum of £3.00 pocket money to spend. This money will be collected on the morning of departure and looked after by an adult during the trip. Please send this with your child in a named, sealed envelope.

Digital devices/trackers

Please note that children are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets on the trip. This includes mobile phones, trackers, tablets or smart watches. We would appreciate your support in enforcing this. Any devices that are brought on to the trip will be confiscated and handed back to adults when we arrive back at school.

Security

The Golden Hinde is not open to members of the public when private groups are on board. Overnight, there will be a member of Golden Hinde staff aboard the ship as well as five members of Stamford Green staff. The children cannot get off the boat by themselves and will be supervised at all times by their group leader.

Y3 Golden Hinde Residential Kit/Packing List

Below is a summary of the kit that the children will need to bring with them. Please note that the items listed below are the items your child will need for the time we are away. Please try not to 'over-pack' as your child will have to carry all of their own belongings from the coach drop off point to the ship and back again, which is a fifteen minute walk. Please pack items like roll up mats so that they can be easily carried/strapped to backpacks etc. Children do need to carry their bags up a flight of stairs and along cobbled streets so a bag on wheels might not be suitable.

On the day, children will need to wear school uniform on the top half (t-shirt and school jumper, both with logos) and comfortable lightweight trousers (not jeans in case they get wet) with comfortable shoes (trainers are permitted). They will wear these clothes again the next day to come back in, so there's no need to pack extra clothes.

All items should be clearly labelled with your child's name:

- Nightwear (pyjamas recommended, rather than nightdresses)
- Underwear for the following day and a spare
- Socks for the following day and a spare pair
- Sleeping bag (wrapped in waterproof bag/durable dustbin liner)
- Roll mat (no big inflatable airbeds please)
- Backpack (to hold overnight clothes)
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Small day rucksack containing: a packed lunch and snacks for the first day in disposable containers/bags (no nuts/ fizzy drinks/ glass bottles or cans please), a water bottle for use at the Tower of London, waterproof jacket, hat/cap and sunscreen.

Please note children must not bring valuables or electronic equipment on the trip.
