YR Visit to Godstone Farm – Thursday 12 June 2025

This term our learning focus moves on to The World Around Us and as part of this we are pleased to inform you that we have arranged a visit to Godstone Farm on Thursday 12 June 2025. This visit will be a valuable contribution to our study of animals as we will learn all about feeding and handling farm animals.

We will be leaving at approximately 9.15am and we should be back at school by 4.00pm, although this is dependent on traffic. We will update the school's Instagram feed with details of our journey, so follow us ([stamford.green](https://www.instagram.com/stamford.green)).

The children should wear tracksuit bottoms, jeans or leggings with their school polo shirt, school jumper, a waterproof coat and trainers. In addition, if the weather looks hot on the morning of the trip, please send in a named sunhat. The children will need a packed lunch and if your child usually has a school meal on a Wednesday, it will be provided by the school kitchen. If your child would like a school packed lunch, please make sure you book this by 4 June. If you wish to send additional snacks to supplement the lunch then you are most welcome to but please respect that we are a nut free school. Children will also need to bring a full water bottle with them.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £22.80 to cover the cost to the school of your son/daughter taking part in the visit described in the information set out above. We confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed visit will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit. If you are currently experiencing financial difficulties please come and discuss the visit and payment with Mrs Druce as there is always a solution and absolute confidentiality is assured. For families in receipt of Pupil Premium/Free School Meals, the premium will cover the cost of your child taking part in the trip.

Digital devices/trackers

Please note that children are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets on the trip. This includes mobile phones, trackers, tablets or smart watches. We would appreciate your support in enforcing this. Any devices that are brought on to the trip will be confiscated and handed back to adults when we arrive back at school.

If you agree to your son/daughter participating in the visit, you will need to log into Scopay and go to the trip section, tick the consent box and pay the voluntary contribution of £22.80. The deadline for payment is Wednesday 21 May 2025. If you have any problems using the online payment system please contact the office.

We are looking for helpers to join us, to keep the children safe and have fun on the day. If you are able to volunteer then please tick the parent helper box on Scopay and we will confirm if you are required to assist once the payment deadline has passed.
