### Year 2's Big Camp

Following the success of previous years, the PTA are very excited to announce that we are running a 'Big Camp' for Y2 at Stamford Green on Saturday 21 June 2025 and we anticipate that this will be a fun event for the adults and children involved.

We are offering 30 pitches for Y2 families (restricted to Y2 children, their parents/carers and siblings at this stage) and places for this event should be booked via the PTA Events website by Friday 13 June 2025 at noon. The cost is £10.00 per adult and £5.00 per child. Infants under 2 are free to attend (no food is included with this option) but for numbers and security purposes a place will need to be booked on PTA Events.

The adult and child ticket includes 1 item from the barbeque (vegetarian options will be available, if you have other dietary needs, please let us know), marshmallows for roasting and a drink from the bar. A bar will be available but campers are asked not to bring their own alcoholic beverages onto site due to licensing restrictions. Smoking and vaping on school grounds is also strictly forbidden.

Breakfast pastries and juice on Sunday morning will be available to pre order. You can only pre-purchase your food from the PTA Events website as it won't be available to buy on the day. Please order in advance, by Friday 13 June 2025 at noon.

Gates will be open between 4.00pm and 4.45pm on Saturday 21 June and parking will be available on the top playground. There will be a 'Big Camp Briefing' at 5.00pm that everyone must attend so that we can ensure safety for all and look after the local residents. The site must be cleared by 10.30am on Sunday morning. A toilet will be available throughout the night.

Please sign up and pay via PTA Events website from Monday 2 June at 9.00am and please note that pitches will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Given this is a PTA event we are hoping that everyone can take a turn in helping on the BBQ, bar, games or marshmallow roasting etc. There will be an option to volunteer to help when you book your ticket. Thank you for your support in advance.

Families joining the Big Camp will need to bring their own camping equipment, an indicative list is as follows:

Tent, sleeping bags, roll mats, pillows, folding chairs, torches and/or head torches, water bottles, warm clothes to sleep in - including warm socks, waterproof jackets (hopefully we won't need them) toothbrushes and toothpaste. You will also need to bring any plates, cutlery and cups as there won't be any provided. You are also welcome to bring any additional nut free snacks.
