Dear Parents/Carers,

Y2 Drusillas Park Trip - Friday 4 July 2025

We are pleased to inform you that we have arranged a visit to Drusillas Park on the above date for all Year 2 classes. These visits will be a valuable contribution to our study of animals and the children will take part in a habitat and adaptations workshop on the day.

To make the most of our time at Drusillas, we will leave school promptly at around 9.00am so please ensure your child/children are in school in plenty of time for registration. We plan to return to school by 4.45pm although this is dependent on traffic. The school will update Instagram (stamford.green) should we encounter any delays. Children should be collected from the East Gate only.

Children should wear school uniform with trainers or comfortable shoes, a sunhat and a waterproof coat. We are hoping the weather will enable us to make use of the water playground on the day. Therefore, please can the children bring with them a small towel in a named plastic bag and a change of top, bottom and underwear (this doesn't have to be school uniform).

They will need to bring a packed lunch (preferably in a carrier bag not lunch box) in their back pack. Please ensure that your child has plenty to drink but no fizzy drinks or glass bottles. Please remember that we are a nut free school and this includes school trips. If your child usually has a school lunch it will be provided by the school kitchen. Please make sure you have ordered your child's school lunch by Wednesday 25 June. If you wish to send additional snacks to supplement the lunch then you are most welcome to.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £22.40 to cover the cost to the school of your child taking part. We confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed visit will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit. If you are currently experiencing financial difficulties please come and discuss the visit and payment with Mrs Druce as there is always a solution and confidentiality is assured. For families in receipt of Pupil Premium/Free School Meals, the premium will cover the cost of your child taking part in the trip

Digital devices/trackers

Please note that children are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets on the trip. This includes mobile phones, trackers, tablets or smart watches. We would appreciate your support in enforcing this. Any devices that are brought on to the trip will be confiscated and handed back to adults when we arrive back at school.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, you will need to log into [Scopay](#) and go to the trip section, click the trip and tick the consent box and pay the voluntary amount of £22.40 by Wednesday 11 June 2025. If you have any problems using the online payment system Scopay, please contact the office.

We will need parent helpers to assist on this trip and would be grateful if you could indicate on Scopay if you are able to volunteer and enjoy the day with us by ticking the parent helper box. We will confirm the offers of help once the payment deadline has passed.
