2 year olds

This week's concept word is: **lots**

At home: what can you spot **lots** of on the way home? For example, **lots** of cars, cats, trees, houses and lamp posts.

3 and 4 year olds

This week's concept word is: **next to**

At home: play the '**next to**' game. When you are out and about, see if you can spot any two things together. For example, Say 'I can see a man **next to** a dog.'

Our skill of the week

This week we are continuing to help the children to understand how we look after the seeds we have planted. Please encourage your child to help out at home with plants in the garden or any house plants indoors.

Reading focus

During our 1:1 reading session with the older children we are looking at familiar sounds we see in the text. Our younger children are practicing saying the missing word in familiar texts for example 'We're going on a bear ?????'
