- Getting to know the Nursery environment.

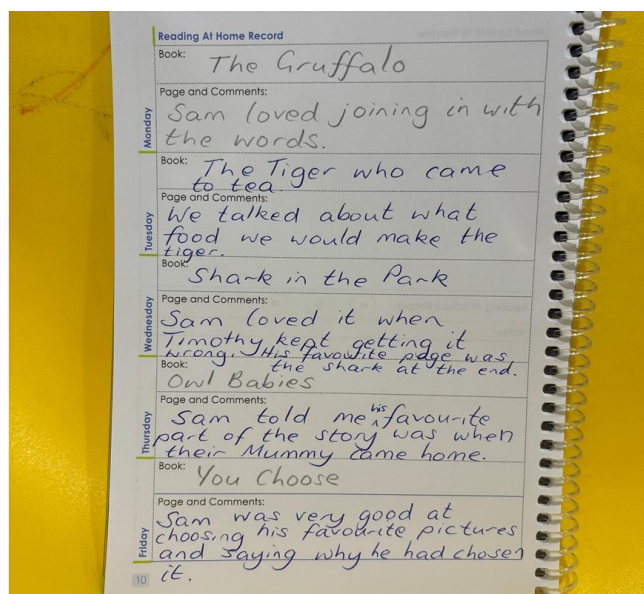
#### Our skill of the week
