Dear Families,

Year 6 Extra Swimming Lessons at the Rainbow Leisure Centre- Certain Children Only

We have an opportunity to provide some extra swimming lessons for some Y6 children. Your child has been identified as someone who would benefit from this opportunity so they can meet the statutory end of Key Stage 2 expectation of swimming 25m.

Swimming lessons are part of the National Curriculum and we are pleased to confirm that we have booked some sessions for Year 6 at the Rainbow Centre. The swimming lessons will be held every day in the afternoons for one week. The children will have their lunch at 11.40am before leaving school. The school has arranged and paid for three instructors to take the lessons and the children will be split into small groups depending upon their swimming ability.

The Rainbow Centre insists that children wear swimming hats, especially if they have long hair, so please make sure your child has one with them. Fabric hats are suitable, if your child finds the latex ones tricky. Please can children have a water bottle and snack with them in addition to the items on the list below.

The cost of these sessions for certain Y6 children has been covered by our Sports Premium funding so there is no charge for the families and the swimming sessions will be taking place during school hours as detailed below:
