PE Kits

Forest School

You will need to bring a pair of wellies to leave at school for Forest School each week and other wet/muddy activities.

Homework

You will be given some books in a pack which is changed each week. Please read each day and record the reading in your Learning Journal.

The pack also includes picture books to share together.

The East and West Gates are open at 8.35am. A teacher will meet you on the first day and show you how to find your class room.

The school day finishes at 3.05pm from the East Gate and 3.10pm from the West Gate pick up point.

Lunch is at 11.40am and school meals can be ordered [here](#) or you may bring a packed lunch. We are a nut free school to help keep those with allergies safe.

Please bring a plastic, sports cap water bottle to school each day – this should contain water only.
