Dear Parents/Carers,

Y3 Visit to the Tower of London – Monday 18 May 2026

As part of our learning about the Tudors in the summer term, we are excited to offer the children an educational visit to the Tower of London on Monday 18 May 2026. This visit will give pupils the chance to explore one of Britain's most historic landmarks, view the Crown Jewels, and walk the famous Tower walls.

The Tower of London visit has previously been part of the Golden Hinde residential trip, however, to promote inclusivity and ensure that as many children as possible can take part in Our Opportunities and Thrive Experiences, we have decided to divide the original trip into two separate visits.

Timings

- **Depart school:** 9.15am
 - **Leave Tower of London:** 3.30pm
 - **Return to school:** Approximately 5.00pm (traffic dependent)

What your child will need

- Wear full school uniform, including school shoes.
- A packed lunch (a school packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen for those who usually have a school lunch – please book this by Wednesday 6 May).
- A small rucksack to carry lunch and a water bottle (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles).
- Optional extra snacks (nut-free).
- Please ensure any medical information and medication is up to date with Mrs Ravago in the school office.

Cost

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £21.50 to cover transport and admission costs. This amount represents the shared cost of the trip across all pupils. Unfortunately, the visit cannot go ahead without sufficient contributions. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please speak confidentially to Mrs Druce – we will always find a solution. Families in receipt of Pupil Premium/Free School Meals will have the cost covered by the school from Pupil Premium funding.

Digital devices/trackers

Please note that children are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets on the trip. This includes mobile phones, trackers, tablets or smart watches. We would appreciate your support in enforcing this. Any devices that are brought on the trip will be confiscated and handed back to adults when we arrive back at school
