Dear Parents/Carers,

3W Residential Trip – The Golden Hinde – Wednesday 3 June 2026 to Thursday 4 June 2026

As part of our learning about the Tudors in the summer term, we have provisionally booked an optional one night residential trip aboard The Golden Hinde in London on Wednesday 3 2026. The children will leave school at approximately 3.30pm and return on Thursday 4 June 2026 at approximately 11.00am. There will then be the option to collect your child at 12.30pm or they can continue to stay at school until the end of the school day.

At Stamford Green we are proud to offer a wider range of optional extra-curricular thrive experiences and opportunities. Any pupil who does not take part in this residential trip will be required in school as usual.

A residential trip is a wonderful opportunity to develop the children's independence and ability to work as a team. The children will be introduced to a sailor's life in Tudor times and take part in different activities. They will have dinner and spend the night sleeping on the gun deck among the cannons. In the morning, they will enjoy a traditional Tudor breakfast. More details about the Golden Hinde can be found on their website: <https://www.goldenhinde.co.uk/>

Until final numbers are known, we cannot provide an exact cost of the trip as the per child cost is worked out by dividing the cost of transport, accommodation and activities by the number of children attending. We are, however, currently working on a figure of between £86.00 - £95.00. As soon as numbers have been confirmed, we will advise you of the final price. The figures quoted are based on all children attending.

The school pay 1.2% card processing charges for all payments on Scopay. For this trip the charge is £1.03 per child, a total of £92.70 for a year group of 90. As you will be aware, school resources are extremely limited so we are kindly asking families to make an additional voluntary contribution to cover this hidden cost. £1.03 has been added to the cost of the trip on Scopay but please note this amount is voluntary. Thank you in advance for your support.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, you will need to log into Tucasi and go to the trip section and tick the consent box and pay a deposit of £30.00 by Monday 12 January. If you have any problems using the online payment system Scopay, please contact the school office or email. parents@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk If we have not received your permission and deposit by Monday 12 January we will assume that you do not wish your child to take part. Unfortunately, once we have booked the trip we may not be able to add any more children so it is important that you respond by the deadline, if you wish your child to attend.

For families in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, the premium will cover the cost of your child attending, so please just tick the consent box if you wish them to attend.

The instalment dates are below, which must be adhered to as a minimum. However, you can pay as often as you like (e.g. weekly, monthly etc. and for different amounts, using Scopay, in addition to the dates listed below:

All payments must be made in accordance with the schedule to secure your child's place. Payments are generally non-refundable. If a refund is due this is calculated in line with the Golden Hinde's terms and conditions. If you would like details please ask. Unfortunately, any account that is in arrears may mean that your child's place on the trip cannot be confirmed and you may lose any deposit and other monies paid.
