Zones of Regulation

This week we are focusing on how we feel when we are in the Green Zone and how we can communicate effectively.

Values

Cooperation is the Club Room value of the week. We will be focusing on developing children's co-operation skills. We will support this by encouraging turn taking during adult led games and activities.

Learning

- Our aims for the children's learning this week are:
- Our learning within the **EYFS** will be play-based, with a focus on supporting smooth transitions throughout the day. Adult-led activities will encourage children to talk confidently about a chosen topic, helping to develop their communication and listening skills.

- In **Key Stage 1**, children will take part in play-based activities designed to develop the skill of co-operation, including sharing, turn-taking and working positively with others.
- In **Key Stage 2**, children will engage in bespoke English and mathematics activities tailored to their individual needs. Alongside this personalised support, there will be a continued focus on developing times tables knowledge and using effective punctuation in writing.
