Word Aware

This week's concept words:

Cygnets

This week's concept word is: **fast**.

You could: on the way home from school, walk **fast** and not **fast**. Find a toy that is **fast**.



Swans

This week's concept word is: **through**.

You could: go for a walk around your house. Talk about the places you can get **through**.



Number of the week

This week we will introduce a daily Maths Meeting. To begin with, we will focus on counting amounts up to 10, subitising (recognising amounts without having to count them) and spotting the odd-one-out. We'll think carefully about how to justify which is the odd-one-out and why.

Here is an example:

Today is **Wednesday**.



What day is it today?

Today is Wednesday. Yesterday was Tuesday. Tomorrow will be Thursday.

How many hearts can you see? How do you know there are three? I wonder how many there would be if we had one more?

Which is the odd-one-out?

E.g.: The dog in the top left corner is odd because it has floppy ears, whereas the rest of the dogs have pointy ears.
