This week, we are:

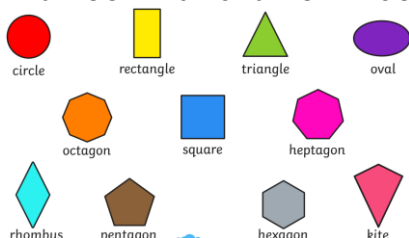
- Learning all about emergency vehicles such as fire engines and ambulances.

Maths:

This week in Swans we will be learning about the 2d shapes: circle, triangle, square and rectangle.



In Cygnets, we will be sorting objects by size. We'll be using the words: small, medium and large. We will continue our daily maths meetings. Here is an example:

Today is Monday.



Here we can think about the number of ambulances. Can you spot how many without having to count? How many would there be if we have one more? What does number 5 look like? Can you see a 4 and a 1?

On the right (in the grid) we will think about which of the images is the odd-one-out. E.g. the image of the 3 nurses is odd because there are 3 people whereas the rest of the images only has one person.

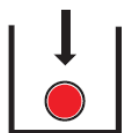
Word Aware
