Dear Parents/Carers,

Y6 Visit to Epsom Ewell Junior Citizen Event – Thursday 5 March 2026

We have arranged for our Year 6 pupils to attend an exciting and useful event at Epsom Downs Race Course, which is organised by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Surrey on Thursday 5 March 2026. In previous years children who have attended have thoroughly enjoyed this event and the skills learnt have proved useful when they have been confronted with emergency situations.

The Junior Citizen Event is a multi agency safety event, designed to provide children with life skills that will enable them to keep themselves and others safe. It is generally accepted that children start to become more independent at this age and are often expected to cope increasingly on their own and deal with changes in their lives, such as a move to secondary school. The aim of The Junior Citizen Event is to raise each participant's awareness of threats and dangers, and what to do, in a fun and interactive way.

In previous years, some of the areas talked about have included: house fires, railways, electricity, water, clever never goes (stranger danger) and nutrition. We will be travelling by coach and leaving school around 9.00am and arrive back at school at approximately 12.15pm. The children should be wearing full school uniform and school shoes.

We would appreciate your support in enforcing this. Any devices that are brought on to the trip will be confiscated and handed back to adults when we arrive back at school. If you would like your child to take part in this trip you will need to log into Scopay and go to the trip section, tick the consent box and pay the voluntary contribution of £11.30 by Wednesday 11 February 2026. We confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed trip will not be viable if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the trip. If you have any problems using the online payment system Scopay please contact the school office. For families in receipt of Pupil Premium/Free School Meals, the premium will cover the cost of your child attending so please just tick the consent box if you wish them to attend. We will need parent/carer helpers to assist on this trip and would be grateful if you could indicate on Scopay if you are able to help and enjoy the trip too.
