We will also practice ways to express these feelings clearly and explore strategies that help manage excitement and nerves so children can remain calm, focused and ready to learn.

#### Values

Our Club Room value of the week remains self-belief. With Year 6 continuing their practice National Curriculum Tests (NCTs), we will be encouraging all children to believe in themselves, trust their abilities and approach challenges with confidence and a positive mindset.

#### Learning

Our aims for the children's learning this week are:

Learning in the **EYFS** will take a play-based approach to identifying and sorting 2D shapes through practical and engaging activities. There will be a continued emphasis on supporting smooth transitions throughout the day.

In **Key Stage 1**, the children will continue to take part in play-based activities link to the yellow zone and identifying excitement and nervous energy. We will also reflect on how we can support others when they feel in the yellow zone.
