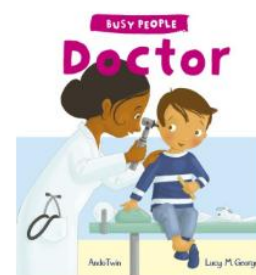
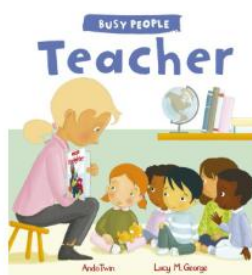
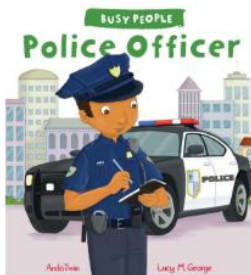

Maths:

This week we will recap our shape knowledge from last week – using the language **sides** and **corners** when naming 2D shapes. We will continue our daily maths meetings, thinking about carefully counting with 1:1 correspondence (only count one item once – you could point to the item or move it away).

This week's concept words:

This week's concept word is: **out**.

At home, you could: put mini-biscuits in containers and then take them **out**. On the bus or in the car, look **out** of the window.



Swans

This week's concept word is: **side**.

At home, you could: look around the living room or bedroom and talk about what is at the **side** of the sofa, bed or television.



Skill of the week:

This week we are working on how to talk to our talk partners (the person we are sat next to on the carpet). This involves turning our body to face them, looking at them when they are speaking and listening to them before speaking back.
