Zones of Regulation

This week, we will be focusing on the Blue Zone. As we near the end of the term, children will be supported to recognise feelings such as tiredness, low energy and feeling unmotivated, and to notice how these feelings show up in their bodies. We will explore gentle strategies to help when energy is low, including rest, movement and asking for help, so children can feel supported, re-energised and ready to keep learning.

Values

Our Club Room value of the week is Making Good Choices. Throughout the week, we will be encouraging children to think about the choices they make and reflect on how these choices affect how they feel, themselves and others. Children will be supported to recognise that positive choices can help them feel proud, calm and confident.

Learning

Our aims for the children's learning this week are:

Learning in the **EYFS** will continue to take a play-based approach towards our learning and also have a focus on our favourite stories and how these can support us when we're feeling tired.

In **Key Stage 1**, children will continue to take part in play-based activities linked to the blue zone and identifying when we may feel tired and have low energy. We will consider different activities that can support us when we are in the blue zone.

In **Key Stage 2**, children will continue to engage in personalised English and mathematics activities. They will also be exploring the world and animals specific to different regions.
