School Uniform	Generic or Logo?
White polo shirt - to be worn tucked in	Logo
Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan	Logo
Grey trousers or shorts (no denim, cord or leggings): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Worn with plain grey socks, ankle length or below the knee (no trainer socks or tights with shorts)</li> </ul>	Generic
Grey skirt or pinafore (no denim or cord): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Length on or below the knee</li> <li>• Worn with grey tights or plain grey socks, ankle length or below the knee (no trainer socks)</li> </ul>	Generic
Summer dress or playsuit – royal blue check: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Optional in warmer weather</li> <li>• Length on or below the knee</li> <li>• Worn with plain white socks, ankle length or below the knee (no trainer socks or tights)</li> </ul>	Generic
Appropriate black shoes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No heels, open toes, strappy sandals, crocs, jelly shoes, boots or trainers</li> <li>• Please, no laces until your child can tie them independently</li> </ul>	Generic

White PE t-shirt	Logo
Plain royal blue shiny PE shorts	Generic
Plain royal blue jogging bottoms	Generic
Royal blue PE fleece (Optional – school jumper / cardigan may be worn for PE)	Logo

Trainers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Predominantly white or black non-fashion trainers</li> <li>• Velcro fasteners until children can tie their laces independently</li> </ul>

<b>Accessories and Equipment</b>	<b>Generic or Logo?</b>
Sun hat / Cap	Generic or Logo
Waterproof coat with hood (no hoodies)	Generic or Logo
Plastic water bottle with a sports cap	Generic or Logo
Royal Blue Book Bag for YR – Y3 (32cm x 37cm)	Generic or Logo
Rucksack for Y4 – Y6 (maximum dimensions are 33cm x 44cm)	Generic or Logo
Royal Blue, drawstring PE kit bag (40cm x 49cm)	Generic or Logo
Wellington boots for YR only	
Only one novelty keyring /tag per book bag, rucksack or PE kit bag is allowed	
The school provides all stationery so no pencil cases should be brought in to school	
	

<b>Personal Appearance</b>	
Watches	Inexpensive, plain analogue watches may be worn and are the child's responsibility but must be removed for PE lessons
Jewellery	No jewellery is permitted except: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain stud earrings, which must be removed by your child for PE lessons / sporting activities</li> <li>• Religious jewellery – please speak to your child's class teacher</li> </ul>
Heads	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Religious headwear must be royal blue or black</li> <li>• No other headwear may be worn inside</li> </ul>
Make-up	Make-up is not permitted
Nail varnish	Nail varnish is not permitted
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair should be neat, tidy and appropriate for a school environment, as defined by the school</li> <li>• Hair longer than shoulder length, should be tied back</li> <li>• Fringes should not obstruct vision</li> <li>• Hair bands, Alice bands and clips may be used</li> <li>• Any hair accessories must be plain and in school colours (royal blue, white, grey or black)</li> <li>• No flowers, scarves or large bows may be worn</li> <li>• Hair colouring, extreme styles and styling products are not permitted</li> <li>• Shaved lines or patterns in hair or eyebrows are not permitted</li> </ul>

The decision about what is and what is not acceptable will always remain with the school.
