Peter Pan – Drama Club Information

As the date for the production of Peter Pan is drawing nearer, we are writing to finalise some of the arrangements for the performance, which will be on Thursday 30 April at 7.00pm.

We would welcome your support in helping your child to learn their lines and songs. At the moment, there are still many children who do not know their lines and so please ensure that they continue to practice them over the Easter holidays.

Rehearsals

In order to be ready for our performance, it has become necessary to extend our rehearsals on Thursday 16 and Thursday 23 April until 4.45pm. There will not be any after school rehearsals the week beginning 27 April as it is the week of the performance!

Costumes

Please see below for a list of the costumes required. We would be grateful if all costumes could be in school by Friday 24 April at the latest. Costumes should be in a named carrier bag and put in the costume box in 1S. Please see below for some ideas for costumes. Footwear should consist of plain black pumps, school shoes, plimsolls or dance shoes, so that the children can move around the stage quietly. If your child is more than one character, we will need a costume for each of their roles please. We have included some ideas of costumes at the end of this letter.

Role in the show	Costume required
Peter Pan	Traditional Peter Pan costume – green trousers, green top, green hat, brown belt – if possible both Peters to wear the same costumes
Wendy	Long blue dress, blue belt and blue bow for her hair
John and Michael	Blue and white stripey pyjamas John will need a black top hat and Michael a teddy bear!
Mrs Darling	Evening dress
Captain Hook/Mr Darling	Smart shirt and tie, trousers Pirate costume including pirate jacket, pirate hat
Lost Boys	Grey, brown, green trousers and t shirts, waistcoats – all dirty looking, could be cut up
Pirates	Pirate costume (no hats)
Neverland Natives	Brown trousers/dress/skirt and top
Tinkerbell	Green Tinkerbell costume
Nana/Crocodile	Green trousers and top

We will update you after the Easter holidays about the ticket sales. We are looking forward to sharing our performance with you so you can see how all the hard work that everyone has put into learning lines, songs and dance routines has paid off.
