This week, we will focus on the Yellow Zone, especially noticing feelings of excitement and nervous energy during transitions. We will be reminding ourselves of strategies that help us manage these feelings so we can feel safe and ready to learn.

#### Values

As we ease back into school, we will be focusing on co-operation in the Club Room. We will be re-visiting children's co-operation skills and we will be encouraging the children to share their holiday news with one another. We will also support this by encouraging turn taking during adult led games and activities.

#### Learning

Our aims for the children's learning this week are:

Within the **EYFS and Key Stage 1**, we will be focusing on smooth transitions throughout the day. Children will take part in play-based activities to develop the skill of co-operation, including sharing, turn-taking and working positively with others.
