## Nursery Weekly Information – w/b 20.4.26

### Forest School

Forest School sessions will begin this week on Tuesday 21 April and Friday 24 April. This is for **Swans** class only.

### Seed Donations

We will begin planting flower seeds this week. If you have any spare packets at home we would be very grateful for any donations.

### Reminder

Please ensure all clothes are clearly labelled, including their waterproof Forest School clothes.

### This week, we are:

- Resettling back into nursery routines.
- Learning all about planting and growing.
- We will be looking at what plants need to grow as well as the parts of a plant.
- Reading a selection of stories and having a go at retelling them using our own words.
- Counting a set of objects and knowing that the last number we say tells us the total without having to recount them. (Cardinality principle)
- Using tools to fix the vehicles in our 'mechanics workshop'.
- Practicing our cutting skills, making sure our thumb is on the top.
- Using our pencil correctly, 'Nip, Flip and Grip.'

### Forest School

This week our Forest School sessions will begin, and they will take place on both Tuesday and Friday. If the weather is due to be very hot for the day, children do not need to come into school wearing their Forest School outdoor wear but please ensure that they have it packed in their bag. We will still run the sessions in wet weather. The children need to come to school in their school shoes fully dressed for Forest School and we will use their school wellies for the forest school sessions which they will change into at school. Welly boots will remain at school and the children will come home in their school shoes.

#### Swans

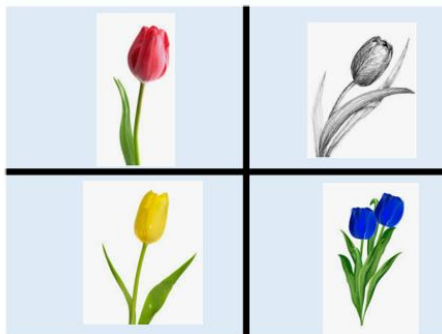


This week's concept word is: **A bit**.

## Maths

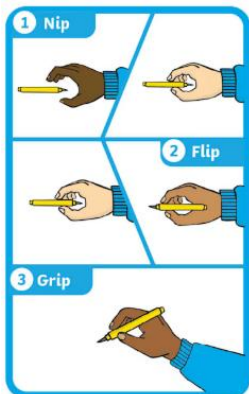
