This week, we are:

- Learning all about minibeasts.
- Making different minibeast artwork for our classroom display using paper plates.
- Going on a minibeast hunt in Forest School.
- Making colour mixing butterflies for our Golden Books.
- Learning about 1 more and 1 less.
- Learning our friendship poem.
- Using a range of different sports equipment in preparation for sports day.
- Sharing a range of stories.
- Using scientific equipment like magnifying glasses to observe minibeasts.

Forest School

Our first Forest School session was a lovely introduction to outdoor learning. The children worked well together, sharing tools like magnifying glasses and binoculars as they explored. They enjoyed searching for minibeasts, carefully looking under logs and leaves while learning to respect nature. We also talked about basic plant parts and what plants need to grow. It was a great start towards building curiosity, confidence, and teamwork outdoors.

Can you spot us hiding in the trees?

Forest School sessions will continue this week. They will take place on both **Tuesday** and **Friday**. Please could all children come to school dressed for Forest School as this allows us more time up on the field to explore and have fun.

We will still run the sessions in wet weather. The children need to come to school in their school shoes fully dressed for Forest School and we will use their school wellies for the Forest School sessions which they will change into at school. Welly boots will remain at school, and the children will come home in their school shoes.

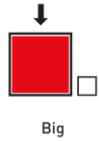


Word Aware
