This week's concept word is: **most**.

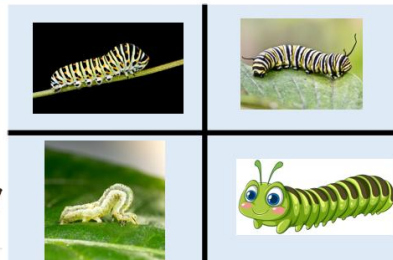


At home you could talk about who has the **most** at dinner-time. It might be the **most** broccoli or the **most** ice-cream.
