Zones of Regulation

This week, we will focus on how we feel when we are in the Blue Zone, noticing feelings such as sadness, tiredness or low energy. We will explore how being in the Blue Zone can affect our bodies, emotions and learning and how to recognise when we or others might be feeling this way. We will practise ways to communicate our feelings and learn how to show kindness and support to others in the Blue Zone.

Values

Our Club Room value of the week is resilience. We will be encouraging the children to keep trying to refocus when we have become confused or distracted. We will be reminding children that we are there to support them when things feel a little tricky at first.

Learning

Our learning aims for the children this week are as follows:
