#### Zones of Regulation

This week, we will focus on the Yellow Zone and how it can link to feelings such as worry, excitement or frustration, especially during NCTs. We will talk about how to recognise these feelings in ourselves and others and practise simple ways to stay calm and focused. We will also think about how we can support each other by being kind, patient and encouraging, particularly when someone might be feeling nervous during test time

#### Values

Our Club Room value of the week is self-belief. We will be encouraging children to trust in their abilities and keep going, even when something feels tricky at first. We will help children recognise how good it feels when they have achieved something through effort and perseverance and remind them that they are supported every step of the way.

#### Learning

Our learning aims for the children this week are as follows:

In the EYFS and Key Stage 1, children will enjoy a range of activities linked to the life cycles of plants, animals and humans.

In Key Stage 2, children will continue to access their personalised English and mathematics learning. Some children will also be focusing on their NCTs. Alongside this, we will be exploring what makes each of us unique and how, as we grow, we develop our own sense of identity.
