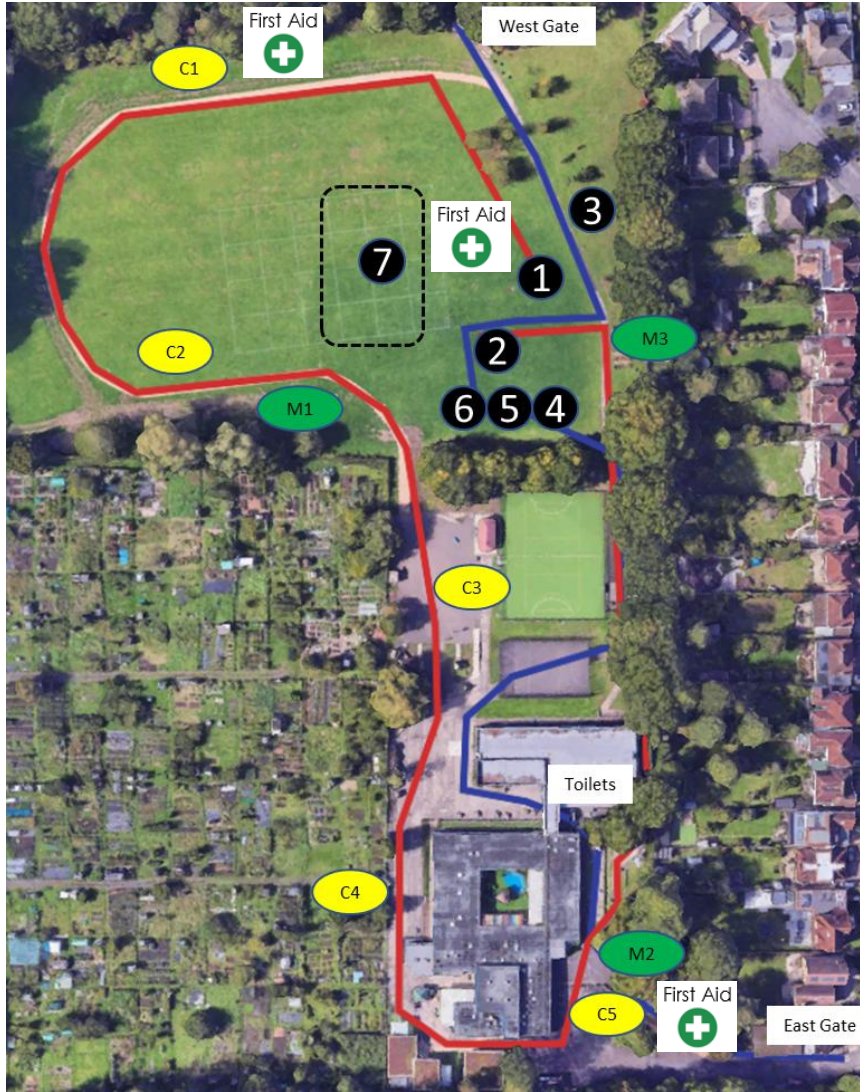
- Anyone participating in the run **MUST** wear eye protection (sunglasses, mask, goggles). You will be unable to participate without it.
- Any comfortable clothes are permitted, but it's recommended that children wear a white t-shirt so they can write their name on it and so that the colour powder is more visible.
- Medals will be handed out at the finish of the race. There are no medals for adults or spectators who choose to run in Wave 4.
- At around 3.15pm we will have our 'Colour Party' on the field, where it is encouraged that children throw the contents of their own colour pouch into the air (not in faces) and celebrate their running achievements together.
- At 3.30pm there will be a Y6 Drama Club performance. At 3.40pm there will be a Y6 Music Festival performance. Please meet by the sound system.
- Be aware that the colour powder may transfer, so a change of clothes or a blanket to sit on for the journey home is recommended.
- We will have a BBQ, bar and ice cream truck where you will be able to purchase food and drink.
- Following the Colour Party there will be performances from some children and live music from 3.30pm. Please bring a picnic blanket and supervise your children for the enjoyment of everyone.
- As per the terms of our licence, we request that you do not bring your own drink to the event.
- If the weather is less than favourable, please bring coats and umbrellas with you. Gazebos are allowed, but only if they are tied down/fixed to the floor so they cannot be blown away.
- Colour run tickets include a hot dog or burger or vegetarian alternative per attendee. These can be collected from the BBQ stand. After 3.30pm all food from the BBQ area will be chargeable.
- Squash will be available for children after the race from the non-alcoholic table at the bar area. Water bottles can also be re-filled at the tap outside 3W.

We hope everyone has as much fun as possible and it's even better than last year's fundraiser!

### Key

 1km loop of Colour Run Course. Start on Top Field, goes through playground down to South Gate, entry into car park then turn around in car park, through car park gate into East Gate, past Reception play area, up the side of school and back onto top field.

 Pedestrian access via East and West Gate. Please note for East Gate route via school and ball cage to Registration/Bar/BBQ. Please only cross the course at Marshall Control point M6 & M8.

1. Start
2. Finish
3. Stage/Warm Up
4. BBQ
5. Bar / Ice Cream
6. Registration
7. Picnic area (**please don't sit in front of the Bar/BBQ**)

C1-C5 – Colour Station locations

C1, C5 and 7 (picnic area) – First Aid stations during the race. Otherwise, please find a member of staff in a high-vis jacket.

M1-M3 – Marshall point locations
