Zones of Regulation

This week, we will be focusing on the Blue Zone. As we approach the half term, we will be reminding the children how to recognise feelings such as tiredness, low energy and a lack of motivation and to understand how these can feel in their bodies. We will also explore gentle strategies to support these moments, such as resting, moving our bodies and asking for help.

Values

Our Club Room Value of the Week is: Making Good Choices. Throughout the week, children will be encouraged to think carefully about the choices they make and reflect on how these choices affect both themselves and others. We will support them to understand that positive choices can help them feel proud, calm and confident.

Learning

Our learning aims for the children this week are as follows:

In EYFS and Key Stage 1, we will be exploring the idea that *change is okay*. Children will learn that sometimes things happen that we may not expect or want, and we can still manage these changes in a positive way.

In Key Stage 2, children will continue to access their personalised English and mathematics learning. Alongside this, we will be focusing on celebrating differences. Children will be developing their understanding that we can sometimes make assumptions based on how people look, and we will encourage them to think carefully about this and to accept others for who they are.
