During the workshop, the children will meet the Story Tree Tickler and use play, imagination, puppets, songs and storytelling to discover how the magical Story Tree was created and how it keeps stories safe forever. As part of our theme 'Which stories do I like to retell?', the children will take part in movement, storytelling and role-play activities designed to build confidence and inspire a love of sharing and retelling stories.
