Dear Parents/Carers,

Y1 Visit to Hampton Court Palace – Thursday 9 July 2026

To fit in with our learning this term, we have arranged a visit to Hampton Court Palace on Thursday 9 July 2026.

We will be leaving school at 9.15am and we will depart the Palace at 2.45pm, so will aim to arrive back at school around 3.30pm. This is dependent on the level of traffic so we will update Instagram (@stamford.green) if there are any changes.

Whilst at the Palace we will be exploring Henry VIII's Apartments, The Tudor Kitchens and The Maze. After lunch we will get some time to enjoy The Magic Garden.

The children should wear school uniform, which includes school shoes and will all need a packed lunch. If your child usually has a school meal it will be provided by Accent. Please book your child's lunch by Tuesday 30 June. If you wish to send additional snacks in you are most welcome to. Please remember that we are a nut free school and this includes school trips. The children will each need a small rucksack to carry their own lunch and water bottle, no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please. Please be mindful they will be carrying their own bag for the duration of the trip and water fountains are available to refill water bottles so there is no need to send more than one bottle. Please ensure that Mrs Ravago in the office has the up-to-date details of any medication that your child will need to take on the trip.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £16.65 to cover the cost. We confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed trip will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the trip. If you would like to pay and are currently experiencing financial difficulties please come and discuss the trip and payment with Mrs Druce as there is always a solution and absolute confidentiality is assured. For families in receipt of Pupil Premium, the premium will cover the cost of your child taking part in the trip.

Digital devices/trackers

Please note that children are not permitted to bring any electronic gadgets on the trip. This includes mobile phones, trackers, tablets or smart watches. We would appreciate your support in enforcing this. Any devices that are brought on to the trip will be confiscated and handed back to adults when we arrive back at school.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip you will need to log into [Scopay](#) and go to the trip section, tick the permission box, and pay £16.65 by Friday 19 June or as soon as possible. If you have any problems using the online payment system Scopay, please contact the school office.

We will need parent/carer helpers to assist on this trip and would be grateful if you could indicate on Scopay if you are able to volunteer and enjoy the day with us by ticking the parent/carer helper box. We will confirm the offers of help once the payment deadline has passed.
