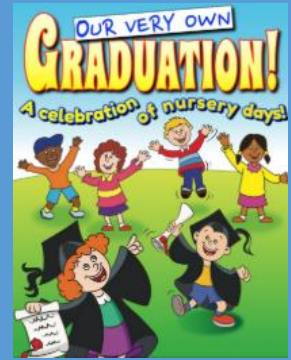




Swans

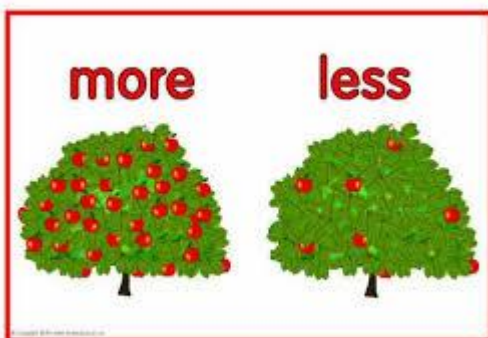
This week's concept word is:
