



Stamford Green Primary School - Nursery Uniform information – 29.6.20

Heads	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sensible haircuts and hair styles appropriate for a school environment with no hair dye, shaving, patterns cut in or gel or similar. Children with long hair (shoulder length) need to tie it back and fringes should not obstruct vision. Plain hair bands, alic bands and clips should be used and where possible should be in school uniform colours e.g. white, royal blue, grey or black. No scarves/ bandanas/ flowers are permitted. Religious headwear should be royal blue/black.
Nails	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No nail varnish is permitted.
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No jewellery please - the only exception is plain stud earrings (which must be removed for PE lessons by children) and religious jewellery but please speak to your child's class teacher about this.
Bodies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sweatshirt – royal blue school sweatshirt with school logo from M&S Uniform. Polo shirt – plain white (no school logo is required for nursery only) Black trousers/shorts/skirts/track suit bottoms/leggings (no denim or cord). These items should be worn with black tights or black socks, which need to be ankle length or below the knee. Trainer socks are not permitted. Please note that the children should be able to go to the toilet independently if wearing tights. Shoes/smart trainers – black or darker colours – (no heels, strappy sandals or boots). Children need to be able to take their shoes on and off themselves so no laces unless they can confidently tie them.
Coats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Waterproof coat complete with hood in school at all times. Warm coat for the colder weather. Gloves if worn should be on a string.
Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School sun hats (royal blue with school logo) are the preferred option but children can use ones from home as long as they are slogan free.

Equipment
