Zones of Regulation

This week, we will be focusing on the Yellow Zone, particularly when routines change and we may feel worried, excited or nervous. We will support the children to recognise these feelings, face their fears by trying new things and reflect on how they feel afterwards, celebrating their achievements and growing confidence. We will also begin to talk about upcoming transitions at the end of the academic year, helping children feel prepared and supported during these changes.

Values

Our Club Room values this week continue to be friendship, team building and resilience. As some pupils attend the High Ashurst residential and others remain in the Club Room, all children will be encouraged to work together, support one another and build resilience through problem-solving and shared challenges.

Learning

Our learning focus this week includes:

In Key Stage 1, we will continue to develop speaking and sentence-building skills. We will also continue to build engagement through sensory circuits, alongside gentle discussions about the upcoming transition to next year, exploring what may stay the same, what might be different and why change can be a positive thing.

In Key Stage 2, the children will work on their individual maths and English activities. Alongside this, we will focus on preparing for the next academic year. Children will take part in discussions about their new classes and teachers, exploring any questions or feelings they may have. They will also be writing an 'All About Me' to share with their new class teacher, helping to support a positive and confident transition.
