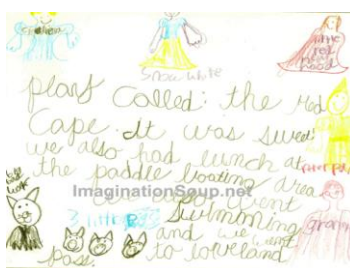
Summer writing challenge
