Dear Year 3 Families,

Year 4 Residential Trip to High Ashurst – Wednesday 5 July 2028 to Friday 7 July 2028

We are excited to be planning the 2028 Year 4 Residential Trip for our current Year 3 children. This is an optional two night residential trip at High Ashurst near Dorking, from Wednesday 5 July 2028 to Friday 7 July 2028. Due to the popularity of this venue, to secure the dates we need, we must book this trip well in advance!

This residential trip is a wonderful opportunity to develop the children's independence and team building skills as well as having lots of fun! High Ashurst Outdoor Learning Centre is set in 56 acres of woodland on Box Hill, near Dorking. The centre offers a wide range of activities such as orienteering and low rope activities. In Year 4 the theme of learning for the summer term is survival and to complement this, the children and staff will be camping out in tepees.

To reserve a place for your child, we are asking for a deposit of £30, payable by Friday 25 September 2026. This deposit will secure your child's place on the trip and allow us to confirm our booking with the provider.

At this stage, we are unable to confirm the final cost of the residential, as prices for the 2027/28 academic year have not yet been released. However, based on previous years, we anticipate the total cost to be approximately £220 per pupil. We appreciate that committing to a trip before the final cost is known may be difficult. Therefore, if you decide that your child will no longer attend and you notify the school by 31 July 2027, we will provide a full refund of the £30 deposit. Should your child leave the school before the trip, they will not be able to attend. If this is before 31 July 2027, the £30 deposit will be refunded. If this is after 31 July 2027, any refund will be dependent on the amount recoverable by the school from High Ashurst or from another pupil taking the resulting space on the trip.

No further payments will be requested for this trip until September 2027. During the Summer term 2027, we will send a further letter with the full details of the trip and a payment schedule for the full confirmed trip cost.

For children who qualify for Pupil Premium funding, either through receipt of Targeted Free School Meals or Ever 6 criteria, the cost of this trip will be covered, so please just fill in the consent form if you wish them to attend. If you are unsure whether your child qualifies for Pupil Premium funding, please contact Mrs Ravago in the school office.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, you will need to log into Scopay go to the trip section, and complete the consent form and pay a deposit of £30.00 by Friday 25 September 2026.
